Lazer & Freya from Squirrels


Millie & Kane from Hedgehogs

#### Flu Vaccinations:

On Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> November the nurse is coming into school to administer the flu vaccine nasal spray for children. Letters will be going out shortly. It is vital you return the slips and state if your child can or cannot have the treatment. No vaccination will be given without the proper parental consent. Thank you.

<u>Millennuim Garden Project:</u> We still continue to work on and improve the garden area as a working class space for the children. We are asking for small donations of pegs, ropes, blankets for den building or clean kitchen utensils for the mud kitchen. <u>Head-lice</u>: Please can everyone check your child's hair! It is the responsibility of every family within the school to regularly check and if necessary treat your children's hair. Please remember: a second treatment will be required 2 weeks later to stop the head-lice from re-hatching. This can be treated via the GP on prescription if required.

<u>Second-hand school jumpers:</u> There are some second hand school jumpers in reception area for sale for £1.50 each. First come first served – all money raised will go to the PTFA to help pay for the children's Christmas parties. Thank you.



#### EDP Books Vouchers - Can you help us?

You still have to apply for a place in the normal way.
