Milk and Fruit in School If your child wishes to have milk in their mid-morning break, please pre-order and pay in the office. The cost is £3.00 for rest of this half term and only applies to children in Squirrels and Foxes. Children in Hedgehogs class will receive free milk all year. All pupils receive a piece of fruit each day as part of the healthy schools fruit scheme.



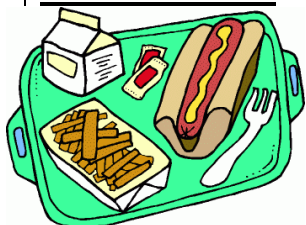
Water in School: Please make sure that your child has his/her water bottle freshly filled with water (not juice or squash) in school every day. Replacement bottles are available from the office priced £1.00.

Term-Time Holidays: Leave of absence during term time will not be granted unless there are exceptional circumstances. Any absences must be reported to the office as usual. A fine may be incurred if requirements are not met.



School Uniforms:

Just to let you know Mrs. Cole and Mrs. Mixer are ready for any uniform demands that you may have, they are all stocked up and ready to go!



School Dinners: We receive freshly prepared meals from Stalham High School who use only local, good quality produce. Packed lunches can be ordered instead of a hot meal. Vegetarian options are available and if your child has other special dietary requirements please let Mrs Cole/Mrs Mixer know. Please make sure that your child knows what their lunch arrangements are to avoid any confusion. If they are having a home packed lunch please make sure their teacher is aware, alternatively please call in at the office to advise.

Healthy Schools at Stalham Infant & Pre School: The school is committed to encouraging a healthy lifestyle and we do ask parents to encourage all children to eat well and one way is to ensure their lunchboxes contain a healthy balance.
